
AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

ORDINANCE NO. 11062006

OBSTRUCTING STREET CROSSINGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


Pursuant to the power granted it under Sections 11-43-61 and 11-47-114 of the Code of Alabama the City Council for the Town of Vance hereby declares:

From the hours of six A.M. (6 A.M.) until ten P.M. (10 P.M.) it shall be unlawful for any railroad company or any employee or agent thereof to obstruct, or cause to be obstructed, in any manner whatsoever, any street, alley, or other public way within the Town limits by means of any locomotive, car, train, or any manner otherwise for a period of time in excess of ten (10) minutes; provided, however, that if any railroad engine, motorcar, handcar, coach, train, or other similar railroad equipment shall come to a full and complete stop, it shall be unlawful for such equipment to obstruct any such street, alley, or other public way for a period of time in excess of five (5) minutes.

From the hours of ten P.M. (10 P.M.) until six A.M. (6 A.M.), it shall be unlawful for any railroad company or any employee or agent thereof to obstruct, or cause to be obstructed, in any manner whatsoever, any street, alley, or other public way within the Town limits by means of any locomotive, car, train, or any manner otherwise for a period of time in excess of thirty (30) minutes.


Violations of this ordinance shall result in a fine of no less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and no more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per each instance of a violation.

ORDINANCE NO. 11062006A

DUTY TO CLEAR RAILROAD CROSSINGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the power granted it under Sections 11-43-61 and 11-47-114 of the Code of Alabama the City Council for the Town of Vance hereby declares:

Upon the sounding of any emergency vehicles, including but not limited to police, fire, and ambulance, or upon the sight of such emergency vehicle of the city going to or coming from an emergency situation, it shall be the duty of all persons in charge of railway trains at or near the street crossings of the Town to clear such crossings and keep the same cleared until the emergency vehicle has passed, or has gone in another direction.

The emergency situation shall be evidenced by the use of the vehicles audible siren or its visual emergency lights.


Violations of this ordinance shall result in a fine of no less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and no more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per each instance of a violation.
