

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY FOR
CERTAIN COVERED ITEMS FOR 2018
(A15-1446)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VANCE, ALABAMA as follows,


1. The Town of Vance adopts the sales tax exemption from municipal sales tax as enabled by Alabama Act No. 2012-256 for "covered items" as defined in said Act, under the same terms, conditions, and definitions as provided by Act No. 2012-256, Alabama Department of Revenue Rule 810-6-3-.66-02ER, and/or other applicable law or rule, for the period 12:01am Friday, February 23, 2018 until 12:00 midnight Sunday February 25, 2018.
2. The Town Clerk is authorized to certify a copy of this ordinance and convey it to the Alabama Department of Revenue as provided by law.
3. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication and expire March 7, 2018. The sales tax exemption provided herein shall apply only for February 23-25, 2018, and shall not apply to any other time unless authorized by a separate, duly adopted ordinance.

Now, January 18, 2018, we the Vance Mayor and Town Council approve the above mentioned Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday for the certain covered items for 2018.

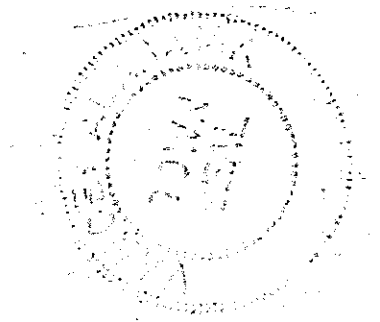


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF VANCE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It is hereby established and declared that the following described real property of the Town of Vance, Alabama, is no longer needed for public or municipal purposes, to wit:



ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:



ORDINANCE 08192019

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE USE OF ELECTRONIC VOTE COUNTING DEVICES FOR USE IN ALL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS


WHEREAS, Chapter 7 of Title 17 of the Alabama Code of 1975, and the Regulations adopted pursuant thereto by the Alabama Electronic Voting Committee, provide for the use of Electronic Vote Counting Systems; and

WHEREAS, Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama 1975 provides that a municipality may, in its discretion, by adoption of an appropriate ordinance, authorize, adopt and direct the use of electronic vote counting systems for use in all elections held in the municipality.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Vance, Alabama, that for all elections held subsequent to the passage of this ordinance, that Tuscaloosa County supplies the Town of Vance with voting devices and that the Town of Vance adopts the DS200 Electronic Vote Counting System that the County will use or any subsequent model device, which complies with Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama and also adopts the use of the AutoMARK voter 8700 System, a system which complies with Section 17-7-21 of the Code of Alabama and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto, is hereby authorized for the reporting, counting, and tabulating of any and all election results.




ORDINANCE NO. 10072019

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND IMPOSE AD VALOREM TAX


