AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council for the Town of Vance hereby authorizes the creation of a Fire Protection District for the Town of Vance and adopts the following procedure for the election thereof:


The election shall take place at the Vance Community Center on April 10, 2007, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

ORDINANCE NO. 07007

SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) Definitions:

For the purpose of this article, the following terms shall have the respective meanings:

Adult criminal sex offender. A person convicted of a criminal sex offense as defined by Code of Ala. 1975, § 15-20-21(4), including a person that has pleaded nolo contendere to a criminal sex offense, regardless of whether adjudication was withheld.

School. A licensed or accredited public or private school or church school that offers instruction in preschool or any of grades K through twelve (12). This definition shall not include private residences in which students are taught by parents or tutors.

Section (2) Residency Restrictions:

It shall be unlawful for any adult criminal sex offender to establish a residence or any other living accommodations or accept employment within three thousand (3,000) feet of the property on which any school is located. The three-thousand-foot restriction shall be measured from the nearest property line upon which the house, apartment complex, condominium complex, motel, hotel or other residence is located to the property line of the nearest school.


Section (3) Established Residents:

Changes to property within three thousand (3,000) feet of an adult criminal sex offender's registered address which occur after an adult criminal sex offender establishes residency shall not form the basis for finding that a criminal sex offender is in violation of section (2) of this Ordinance.

Section (4) Violations:

Violations of this Ordinance shall be a Class C Misdemeanor and the perpetrator may be subject to all applicable fines and imprisonment as found in §§ 13A-5-1 thru 13A-5-10.1 of the Code of Alabama (1975).

ORDINANCE NO. 090407

REQUIRED WASTE RECEPTACLES AND CLEAN UP

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE:

All parties applying for and receiving an authorization from the Town of Vance to begin any construction, building, or demolition shall be required to have an approved on site garbage receptacle prior to beginning any permitted action to contain and dispose of all construction or demolition debris that is accumulated from the permitted actions. The Building Inspector for the Town of Vance may grant an exception from this requirement in the event compliance would result in unreasonable inconvenience or undue hardship.

SECTION TWO:


Further, no construction or demolition site shall have debris on the ground from their activities which would be considered a nuisance or littering of the area of the activities or any adjoining areas.

SECTION THREE:


The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any provision within this ordinance is declared to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and unaffected by that determination.

Violations of this ordinance are as determined by the building inspector and punishments are to be in accordance with the building code and regulations.

ORDINANCE SETTING QUALIFICATION FEES
ORDINANCE NUMBER 020408B

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VANCE, ALABAMA,
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A non refundable qualification fee in the amount of \$35.00 is hereby fixed and imposed upon all candidates seeking election as mayor of the Town of Vance, Alabama, except as hereinafter provided for.

Section 2. A non refundable qualification fee in the amount of \$25.00 is hereby fixed and imposed upon all candidates seeking election as councilmember of the Town of Vance, Alabama, except as hereinafter provided for.

Section 3. Such qualification fees shall be paid to the town clerk and deposited to the general fund of the town at or prior to the time taking out qualification papers by any such candidates.

Section 4. Any person desiring to qualify who is not financially able to pay the required fee may qualify provided such prospective candidate furnishes the clerk with an affidavit stating that he or she is financially unable to pay the required fee fixed by this ordinance.*

Section 5. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 11-46-2 of the Alabama Code of 1975 and shall be effective in all elections, both general and special, for aforesaid offices from and after the date of adoption.

SECTION 1. That the Town governing body of the Town of Vance, Alabama, shall consist of a mayor and five councilmember's who shall be elected by a vote of the voters at large in the Town of Vance, Alabama.

Section 2. That the places on the Town Council are and the same hereby designated as Place Number 1, Place Number 2, Place Number 3, Place Number 4 and Place Number 5.

Section 3. That each candidate for a place on the Town Council shall in the announcement of his or her candidacy designate by number the place for which he or she is a candidate and no person shall be a candidate for more than one place.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE MONTHLY SALARY
OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS
ORDINANCE NUMBER 020408**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE,
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary of the mayor of the Town of Vance, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,000.00 per month.

Section 2. That the salary of the mayor pro tem of the Town of Vance, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$300.00 per month.

Section 3. That each councilmember shall be compensated at the sum of \$200.00 per month.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November, 2008, and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Such qualification fees shall be paid to the town clerk and deposited to the general fund of the town at or prior to the time taking out qualification papers by any such candidates.





BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VANCE,

Section 1. That the salary of the mayor of the Town of Vance, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,000.00 per month.

Section 2. That the salary of the mayor pro tem of the Town of Vance, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$300.00 per month.

Section 3. That each councilmember shall be compensated at the sum of \$200.00 per month.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November, 2008, and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the council.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF VANCE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It is hereby established and declared that the following described property of the Town of Vance, Alabama, is no longer needed for public or municipal purposes, to wit:


