


R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, an Annexation Petition, executed by J. M. Kellum, of the Champion International Corporation, has been filed with the Town Clerk pursuant to Act No. 1437 of the 1971 Alabama Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VANCE:

WHEREAS, the Town of Vance's Preapplication for Discretionary Funding under Section 570.400 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 has been reviewed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and


WHEREAS, the Town is eligible for consideration in a formal full application of a maximum grant amount up to \$50,000, and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to join with Tuscaloosa County to make a joint application for a grant under the Community Development Act of 1974,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Vance that:

1. The Town of Vance enter into a cooperative agreement with Tuscaloosa County to make a joint application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant under Section 570.400 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 for the purpose of obtaining a grant of not more than \$50,000 to purchase property and to build a community center and recreation facility.
2. At least two Public Hearings be advertised and held to encourage citizen involvement in the preparation of this application and in the selection of projects to be funded by this application.
3. The Mayor of the Town of Vance is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file such application in cooperation with Tuscaloosa County, to advertise and hold Public Hearings, to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required, and to act as the authorized representative of the Town of Vance.
