EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR  
STATE MENTAL HEALTH BOND ISSUE

WHEREAS, all State mental health facilities have been upgraded and improved except Bryce State Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the administrative building at Bryce Hospital is more than 128 years old and does not currently meet minimum safety standards; and

WHEREAS, humane, quality treatment cannot be rendered in such a defective environment; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has proposed a \$70 million bond issue for mental health with \$35 million to be spent for improvements at Bryce Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Bryce Hospital is the second largest employer in Tuscaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, sixty percent of all state mental health workers are employed in Tuscaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the duty and obligation to provide effective, humane and passionate care and treatment for mental health patients.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ~~TOWN~~ COUNCIL OF THE ~~TOWN~~ OF JANCE ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Alabama State Legislature is urged to approve in its legislative session beginning in February 1988, the proposed \$70 million bond issue for mental health.

The following Resolution was offered by George Rouch  
and Mary Martin seconded said Resolution.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Act 515 of the 1945 Legislature, as amended, the employees of the Town of Vance are eligible to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that public employees of the Town of Vance be covered under an annuity and pension plan, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Vance agrees regular full-time and certain part-time employees should be allowed to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Vance, Alabama, that the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama is hereby adopted as the official retirement plan for all regular full-time and certain part-time employees of the Town of Vance, who are otherwise eligible to participate in said System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the approval of the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama, to be effective April 1, 1984, that the following provisions be included:

1. All positions on a full normal working time basis, as well as part-time employees who work at least 20 hours per week and earn no less than the prevailing minimum wage, shall be eligible for participation. Temporary employees are not eligible.
2. The Town of Vance agrees to make all prior service contributions at the rate as determined by the Actuary of the Employees' Retirement System with State prior service rate to be applicable until such determination of prior service rate is made.
3. The Town of Vance agrees to make contributions at the normal rate for current service, which is the same as the State normal rate.

4. The Town of Vance agrees to pay for the initial cost of a preliminary valuation by the Actuary to determine the accrued liability on account of prior service and to pay any other cost for Special Services of the Actuary plus the regular administrative cost of operation of the System.
5. The Town of Vance agrees to submit all information as required by the Employees' Retirement System relative to its employees.
